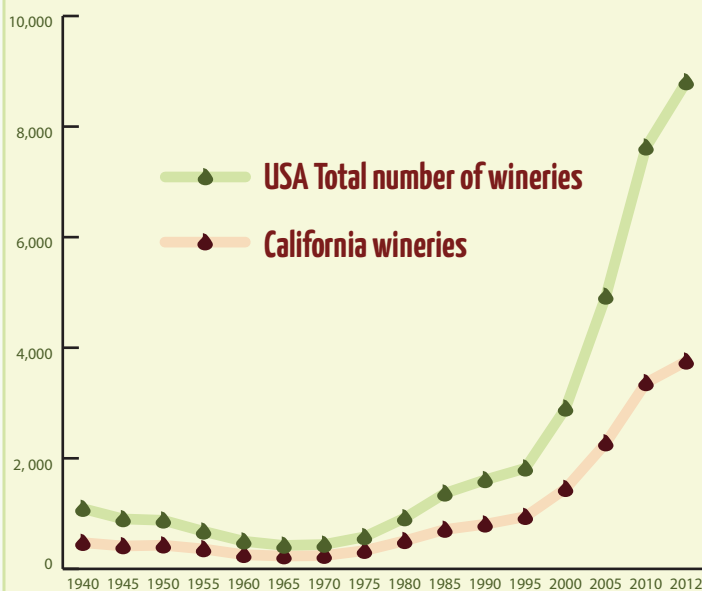

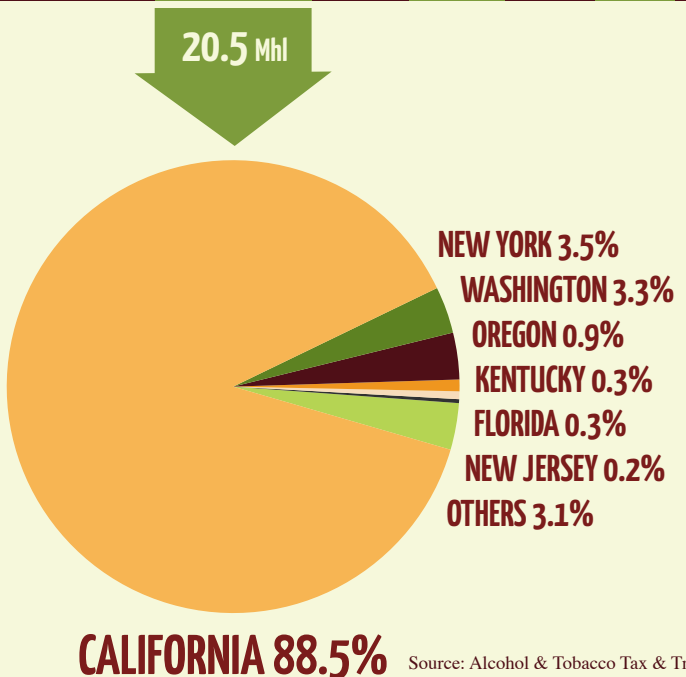
USA was the world's 4th largest wine producer in 2012 with 20 Mhl of wine.

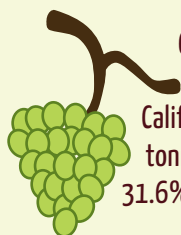

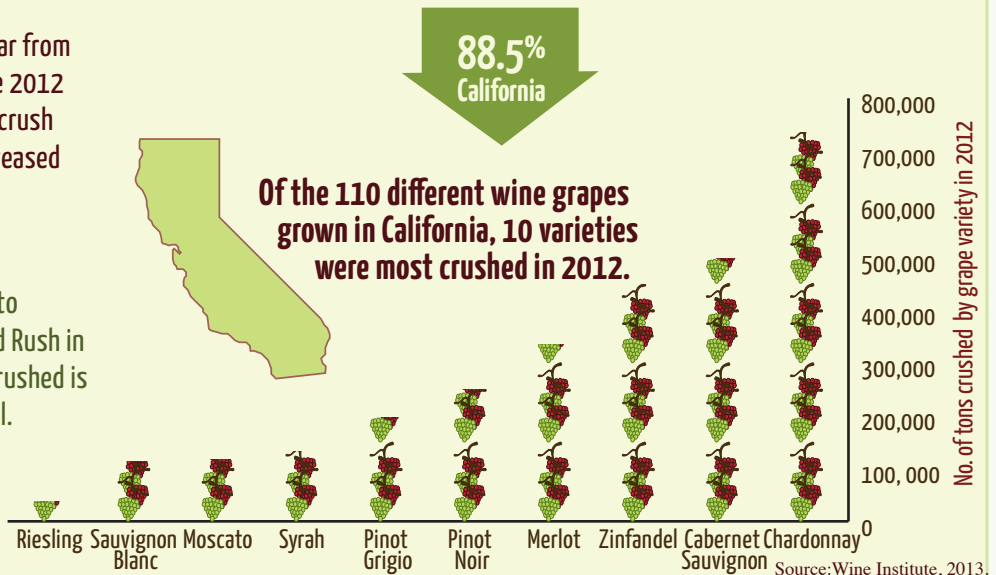
2012: 43% of all US wineries were in California but produced 88.5% of the wine.



Chardonnay became popular from the 1970's onwards. The 2012 Californian Chardonnay grape crush tonnage of 736,000 tons increased 31.6% from the previous year.



Zinfandel was introduced to California during the Gold Rush in the 1850's. Much of the Zin crushed is used to make White Zinfandel.
